# PLAN OF ACTION CHALKED OUT, IN THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR TOWARDS QUALITY ENHANCEMENT

During the year 2005-06 IQAR's plan of action for the year included:

a) Activities to implement the balance suggestions given by the NAAC Peer Team. Most of the suggestions given were implemented in the year 2004-05 and the rest were implemented

- during the year 2005-2006. The implementation of these suggestions would basically lead to quality enhancement.
- b) Activities at the College level, which would further lead to quality enhancement. This includes:
  - 1) Introduction of new courses for the students.
  - Planning seminars and workshops for both teaching and non-teaching staff.
  - 3) To set up a centre for utilization of Instrumentation

    Maintenance Facility Cell (IMF) from the grant received.
  - 4) Planning for remedial coaching classes for the students.
  - 5) Planning for the new library software.
  - 6) Follow up for research centres for the departments, which have applied for the same.
  - 7) Encouraging the faculty members to apply for major and minor research projects.
  - 8) Upgradation of Gymkhana and Sports facilities.

#### OUTCOME BY THE END OF THE YEAR

#### 1) Approval received for research centres: -

During the year 2005-2006, the College received the sanction to start research centres in the Department of Marathi, Physics and Geography.

With this, the College now has four research centres, the first research centre being in the Zoology Department.

#### 2) Setting up of IMF Cell: -

Instrumentation Maintenance Facility grant received is being utilized by setting up of IMF cell. One technician has been appointed exclusively for this purpose and instrumentation maintenance work for colleges in Ahmednagar district is going on.

#### 3) Approval for Major/Minor research projects: -

The Department of Science and Technology, New Delhi has approved and sanctioned a grant of Rs. 22 lakhs to the P.G. Department of Physics and Rs. 22 lakhs to the Zoology department under the scheme 'Funds for Improvement of Science and Technology Infrastructure' (FIST).

In addition to this, eight minor research projects were approved by the UGC.

#### 4) New Courses started during the academic year: -

The following new courses were added to the academic programme of the college.

- a) Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA).
- b) Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA).
- c) Bachelor of Science in Biotechnology

The response to the new courses introduced has been very encouraging.

#### 5) <u>Library automation work</u>: -

The new software SOUL (Software of University Libraries) made by Inflibnet has been installed along with three new computers and server. The 'e-library work is in progress.

#### 6) Refresher Course in Environmental Awareness: -

In addition to the seminars and workshops conducted by various departments, a refresher course on behalf of the Academic Staff College, University of Pune was held in the College in the subject of 'Environmental Awareness.' This refresher course was for all faculties of all streams i.e. Arts, Commerce and Science. It was well attended by faculty members from Ahmednagar District Colleges.

#### 7) Setting up of additional English Language Laboratory: -

An English language laboratory has been set up which will help the students from different streams in spoken English.

#### 8) <u>Upgradation of Sports Facilities</u>: -

The College has been sanctioned a grant of Rs. 2 lakhs by the District Sports Officer, Ahmednagar. The grant is being used for the Upgradation of sports facilities in the College.

#### 9) Appointment of additional staff: -

Additional staff both teaching and non-teaching were appointed after getting the necessary permissions from the Director of Education, Pune.

It is expected that the above steps taken will help in the quality enhancement in the college.

New courses like BBA, BCA and B.Sc. (Biotech) have been introduced after considering the current needs of the students and community.

Research is a benchmark of quality in education. The College currently has 20 Ph.D. and M.Phil guides, 49 students registered for Ph.D. and 13 for M.Phil. With approval received, the College will have 4 research centres in different departments. It has on going one major and 18 minor research projects.

#### c) Hostel facilities: -

The College already has 7 hostels for boys and girls. In addition to this the College is planning for an additional wing for the girls.

#### d) Other activities: -

The college continues to have an inclusive admission policy which encourages girls, minorities, and out of state students.

The college also made scholarship available to about 1716 students. These scholarships are in various categories.

Various programmes for all round development of the students were carried out through various associations and festivals organized by the different departments of the College.
